| Boys U14 (12 - 13 years) Girls U14 (12 - 13 years) | 9 - 7 kyu - Taikyoku Shodan, Heian Shodan, Heian Nidan. May be repeated every other kata. 6 > kyu - can be repeated every third tokui kata. |

NOTE: An athlete may additionally compete in an older age group based on his/her Kyu

NOTE: An athlete may additionally participate in an older age group in his/her weight category. The Team Manager or Coach assumes responsibility for the Athlete's participation in the specific age category or older age category and for the Athlete's preparation for the competition.

RULES

WKF rules as may be amended by the organisers (with full extensions). In case of 3 athletes in a group - circle system.

KATA: U8, U10, U12, U14 - flag system. Two athletes participate at the same time and perform the selected kata. In the finals the athletes perform the selected kata separately.

KUMITE: U8, U10 - 1 minute, up to 6 points difference; U12, U14 - 1,5 minutes, up to 6 points difference.

NOTE: If there are less than two entries in a category, it is possible to merge the category with another category.

AWARDS

1st place winners will be awarded cups and medals, 2nd place and two 3rd place winners - medals.

SECURITY

Mandatory protection: capos, red and blue gloves and leg guards, red and blue belts, body guards are recommended for girls in all groups, and **in U8 and U10 it will be possible to leave leg coverings unHeianged**. The coach who prepared the athlete is responsible for the athlete's technical preparation in accordance with the requirements of karate competitions and rules. The organisers are not responsible for any injuries sustained by an athlete during the competition. Participants are obliged to take care of their health insurance.

ENTRY FEE:

30 EUR - one event.

+15 Euros for each additional **event**

PROTEST:

The protest shall be made in writing within one minute in the presence of the athlete. A protest may be lodged by an official of the team with the Chief Referee. The cost of the protest is 100 €. The protest shall be reviewed immediately after submission. If the protest is upheld, the deposit will be refunded.

APPLICATIONS:

Note: When you register your club in the system, please let the administrator matas.zymantas@gmail.com know and he will give you access to register your athletes. Please check with the system administrator for any registration issues.

REGISTRATION, JUDGING: Registration of participants will take place on 09-11-2024 from 09.30 to 11.00.

The maximum weight overrun is 200 g for boys, 500 g for girls

COMPETITION PROGRAMME:

11:30 - 13:00 - Kata competition.

NOTE: Depending on the number of registered athletes, the times of the tournament categories may Heiange. The schedule will be sent on the eve of the tournament.

ATTENTION: Only competition staff, athletes and coaches wearing athletic footwear or trainers will be allowed in the hall near the courts.

Spectators and accompanying parents will only be able to watch the event in the stands. Team leaders are responsible for the ethical behaviour of their team during the competition.
